Dear Council President Clarke:

I am writing in response to questions raised at the March 31st, 2014 hearing before the Committee of the Whole on the Fiscal Year 2015 budget for the Office of Housing and Community Development. The questions were recorded as follows:

From Councilman Jones:

1. How many affordable housing units were produced last year?

For the year ending June 30, 2013, 170 units of new affordable rental housing were produced (meaning construction completed), 21 units of new affordable homeownership housing were produced and 35 units of affordable rental housing were preserved.

For the year ending June 30, 2014, 425 units of new affordable rental housing are projected to be completed, 8 units of new affordable homeownership housing are projected to be completed and 496 units of affordable rental housing are projected to be preserved.

2. Can you provide to the Chair a list of the organizations and location of the vacant lots that PHS has worked with?

Attachment 1 lists the Community LandCare groups, the Philadelphia LandCare Maintenance groups and the Philadelphia LandCare Stabilization contracts.

3. How many contracts do you currently have with Neighborhood Advisory Committees?

OHCD currently holds 19 contracts with Neighborhood Advisory Committees.

4. Can you provide to the Chair the neighborhoods that the Neighborhood Advisory Committees represent and the dollar value of the contracts? Can you also provide a projection for the next fiscal year?

Attachment 2 lists the Neighborhood Advisory Committee contracts, the addresses and the Service Areas. It is anticipated OHCD will hold contracts with the same number of organizations next fiscal year.

5. How many homeless people are in the City of Philadelphia?

This question would be answered by the Office of Supportive Housing under a separate cover.

6. How many requests do you get for housing assistance on an annual basis?

The housing counseling agencies under contract to OHCD received over 12,300 requests for housing assistance last year. This high level of demand has been fairly consistent for the past five years. PHDC received 5,240 requests for assistance in 2013. In addition, OHCD funds agencies such as the Neighborhood Energy Centers (over 1000 requests), Utility Emergency Services Fund (over 800 requests), and Rebuilding Together Philadelphia (over 300 requests). While it is difficult to determine an exact number, it is estimated OHCD-funded agencies receive well over 20,000 requests for assistance annually.

7. Does OHCD monitor the subcontract information that gets the request for housing assistance?

Yes. OHCD monitors its housing counseling contracts. Attachment #3 lists the housing counseling contracts.

8. How many requests do you get for housing counseling per year?

OHCD received over 12,300 requests for housing assistance last year. This high level of demand has been fairly consistent for the past five years.

9. How many people did you prepare for home ownership last year?

OHCD-funded housing counseling agencies offered pre-purchase counseling to 2,258 households last year and 237 homebuyers received the \$500 Settlement Grant.

10. How many requests for weatherization did you get last year?

PHDC received 2,500 requests for weatherization assistance last year.

11. One out of every 20 school district students experience homelessness, how are we going to address that going forward?

This question would be answered by the Office of Supportive Housing under a separate cover.

Neighborhood Advisory Committees: Service Areas¹




