### Dear President Clarke:

This letter is in response to questions raised at the April 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2014 hearing before the Committee of the Whole on the Fiscal Year 2015 budget for the Revenue Tax Bills. The questions were recorded as follows:

### From Councilman Johnson:

1. Can you provide to the Chair the number of people that foreclosed on their homes because they defaulted on their payment agreement during FY13?

During FY13, 156 non-commercial properties defaulted on their payment agreements and went to Sheriff Sale. We are not able to determine which were owner-occupied residences prior to the sale.

# 2. Can you provide the payment agreement information by Council District or zip code?

The chart below shows the payment agreement data for Real Estate Tax prepared as of May 2014:
