Dear Council President Clarke,

This letter is in response to questions raised after the May 19, 2020 hearing before the Committee of the Whole on the Fiscal Year 2021 proposed budget for the Department of Revenue.

Councilmember Gym: How much did the City raise from each of the net income and gross receipts portions of BIRT in each of the last five years?

Please note, Tax Year 2019 is not due until July 15, 2020. For this reason, Revenue is providing Tax Years 2014 - 2018.

IV. How many out-of-state audits were conducted? What were the total, average, and median taxes recovered from audits?

Although Revenue does not differentiate "out-of-state" audits within the City's tax system, the Department works to uncover tax evasion at all levels. We have undertaken multiple projects to tackle online retailers, petroleum companies, and un-registered contractors, among others. We also utilize outside collection agencies to identify out of state businesses doing business within the City.

We are working to compile results of these various projects and will send as soon as we are able.
