Where to Apply:

Contact the Philadelphia Veterans Advisory Commission at 215-686-3256 to set up an appointment.

Veteran's Eligibility Criteria:

- 100% service-connected disabled (or their surviving spouse)
- Demonstrates a financial need

The Following Documents are Needed:

- Pennsylvania identifying (one of the following)
 - a. Driver's license
 - b. Voter registration card
 - c. Veterans benefit check
- Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty, also known as your DD214 and/or military service records.
- 100% Disability Award Letter from the Veterans Administration and code rating letter, if possible.

- Social Security Benefit Statement (Form 1099 Miscellaneous Income)
- Income tax return
- Employment Income (Form W-2)
- Pension, Annuities, Retirement, Profit sharing, IRA, Insurance contracts, etc. (Form 1099-R)
- Interest Income (Form 1099-INT) and/or Dividend Income (Form 1099-DIV)
- Deed to property, if available.

If You are the Spouse of the Veteran You Must Have the Following:

- The above information as it pertains to you.
- Marriage license
- Death certificate, if applicable.
