Mission: The Board of Building Standards is an advisory board that reviews appeals related to building safety and the application of Philadelphia's Building Code, makes recommendations on regulations and standards to the Commissioner of the Department of Licenses and Inspections, and reviews new building products for compliance with City safety standards.

Plans for Fiscal Year 2018: The Board of Building Standards (BBS) will continue to focus on matters affecting building safety and is faced with interpreting technical issues involving the application of the Building Code. The BBS offers advice to the Commissioner of the Department of Licenses and Inspections, who may then grant a variance based on this advice. Denials can be appealed to the Court of Common Pleas within 30 days of notice of decision.
