## Dear Council President Clarke:

This letter is in response to a question raised at the May 8, 2019 hearing before the Committee of the Whole on the Fiscal Year 2020 proposed budget for the Department of Revenue. This response is for the outstanding question not answered in our letter dated May 21, 2019. The remaining question was:

**Councilman Domb**: Provide a breakdown of how much the City gets from the Sheriff's Office from delinquent taxes and fees.

A total of \$43.9 million in taxes and fees tracked by the Department of Revenue have been received from the Sheriff in FY19 through May 10, 2019. This included current and delinquent Real Estate Taxes, Transfer Tax, Water and Sewer, City Liens, Poundage, and Conduct. This does not include amounts paid by the Sheriff for PGW liens and deed filing, which are not tracked by Revenue.
