This letter is in response to questions raised at the April 2, 2019 hearing before the Committee of the Whole on the Fiscal Year 2020 proposed budget for the Office of the Director of Finance. At this hearing, the following question was asked:

Councilman Jones: Please provide the schedule for bridge repairs, with specifics regarding the 59th Street bridge.

The table below details the Streets Department's Bridge Plan for years 2019-2023. This includes the Name/Location of the bridge, the project's scope, Councilmanic district in which the bridge is located, the timeline for design and construction phases of each bridge, with accompanying cost estimate, source of funds, and comments.
