Dear President Clarke:

This letter is in response to questions raised at the April 2, 2014 hearing before the Committee of the Whole for the Department of Parks and Recreation. The questions were recorded as follows:

## From Councilwoman Brown:

1. Can you provide to the Chair an analysis on how much it would cost to keep the KEYSPOTS open five days a week?

At current funding levels, Parks and Recreation KEYSPOTS operate five-days a week providing 15 hours a week of open access and instruction. To open each Parks and Recreation KEYSPOT an additional 5 hours a week (increase from 15 to 20 hours a week) would cost approximately \$66,500. To open each Parks and Recreation KEYSPOT an additional 10 hours a week (increase from 15 to 25 hours a week) would cost approximately \$133,000.
