This letter is in response to questions raised at the April 18, 2018 hearing before the Committee of the Whole on the Fiscal Year 2019 proposed budget for the City of Philadelphia Department of Human Services. At this hearing, the following questions were asked:

**Councilwoman Helen Gym:** Please provide the average caseload per DHS worker.

The average case load size for a social work service manager in the DHS ongoing services region is 11.5.

Additionally, the average case load for a CUA case manager is 11.2.

**Councilwoman Maria Quinones Sanchez:** Please provide the total increase in insurance for CUAs.

Under each of these major categories are various levels of care, each with a different rate. The cost per child would depend on the level of care and the number of days that the child received the service.
