# Instructions on How to Purchase a Voluntary Youth Fishing License or Mentored Youth Fishing Permit:

### Important -The Youth's Social Security Number and Date of Birth must be used to purchase this permit/license

- Start: Go to HuntFish.PA.gov
- The Homepage will appear.
- Existing Customers will go to Account Lookup if they have a CID# in either the PA Fish or PA Game system.
  - Identifying information will be entered to pull Customer's profile up.
  - From the Welcome Back Page, customers are taken to the Residency Page. Are you a Resident of the State of Pennsylvania? Resident or Non-Resident will be selected.
  - The customer is taken to the Review Summary Page, where an email address is required and will edit any other personal information unless grayed out, in which they would call the Help desk for edits such as SS#, DOB.
- If a first-time customer who has never had a CID# in Pennsylvania
  - Customers will go to Create a New Account and enter all the required information.
  - For first time Customers, questions to verify the customer has not had a license and that they need the ability to purchase a license and if they are a US Citizen will appear.
  - Customers will see the below questions.
  - Have you previously purchased a hunting or fishing license in Pennsylvania?
  - Do you need the ability to purchase a Hunting or Fishing License?
  - Are you a United States citizen?
  - Once the Customer answers the above questions, the Customer will enter personal information and follow the prompts.
  - A New or Existing Customer can create a username and password. The username and password step are not required if the Customer has a CID # and a profile in the Pennsylvania Automated Licensing System.
- Once this is completed, the Customer will be at the Customer's Homepage.
- Customer will select Buy Licenses
  - Select the Fish Tab o Select the appropriate permit/license: 109-Mentored Youth Fishing Permit Annual or 110-Voluntary Youth Annual Fishing License
  - The Add to Cart screen will appear.
  - This screen allows the Customer to verify the item or cancel if the item was selected in error.
  - Click Add to Cart
  - The Shopping Cart screen is presented with the item selected, price and the ability to Keep Shopping or Checkout o If other items are needed, select Keep Shopping, and add products.
  - Once credit card payment is processed, the Order Receipt screen will appear.
  - License Documents and Receipt will be printed at this time.
  - Customers can create a username and password at any time if desired.
  - Customers can edit their profile with exceptions such as Social Security Numbers, Date of Birth, Name Changes at any time.

## Instructions on How to Purchase a Hunting License for Youth in Pennsylvania

Resident Junior Hunting License (\$6.97): Issued to bona fide residents of Pennsylvania ages 12 through 16. Eleven-year-olds may apply for a junior license if they reach age 12 by June 30 of the current license year and have successfully completed the required Hunter-Trapper Education Course. The actual hunting privileges granted to the junior license holder may not be exercised until he or she reaches age 12. In addition to the junior applicant's signature, a parent or guardian must sign the license to validate it and the information provided before the junior license holder goes afield. No archery, muzzleloader or furtaker add-on privileges are available for this license. If a junior wants any of these privileges, he or she must purchase a Junior Resident Combination License. Combination licenses include archery, muzzleloader, and furtaker privileges in addition to one spring turkey, one fall turkey, and one antlered deer tag. This license also includes small game hunting privileges.

Resident Junior Combination License (\$9.97): Issued to bona fide residents of Pennsylvania ages 12 through 16. Eleven-year-olds may apply for a junior combination license if they reach age 12 by June 30 of the current license year and have successfully completed the required Hunter-Trapper Education Course. The actual privileges granted to the junior combination license holder may not be exercised until he or she reaches age 12. In addition to the junior applicant's signature, a parent or guardian must sign the license to validate it and the information provided before the junior license holder goes afield. Combination licenses do not include bear, migratory game bird, special spring gobbler or antlerless deer license privileges. This license includes one antlered deer tag, one fall turkey tag, one spring turkey tag and small game hunting and furtaker privileges for one license year. Archery and muzzleloader privileges are also included with this combination license.

Mentored Youth Permit (\$2.97): Issued to resident and nonresident youth between 7 and 11 years old at the time of application. In addition to the applicant's signature, the applicant's parent or guardian must sign the permit to validate it and the information provided before the mentored youth hunter goes afield. This permit includes one antlered deer tag, one fall turkey tag and one spring turkey tag. The cost to replace a lost Mentored Youth Hunt Permit is \$2.97. See current Digest for additional details.

Mentored Youth Permit – No Tags (\$2.97): Issued to resident and nonresident youth younger than 7 years old at the time of application. In addition to the applicant's signature, the applicant's parent or guardian must sign the permit to validate it and the information provided before the mentored youth hunter goes afield. This permit does not include any game tags. The cost to replace a lost Mentored Youth Hunt Permit is \$2.97. See current Digest for additional details.

Resident Mentored Junior Hunting Permit (\$6.97): Issued to bona fide residents of Pennsylvania ages 12 to 16 years at the time of application. Applicants may not have held a hunting or furtaker license in Pennsylvania or any other state or nation, or a Mentored Youth Permit for three or more years. This permit is eligible to purchase for three years only. This permit includes one antlered or flintlock deer tag, one fall turkey tag and one spring turkey tag. In addition to the applicant's signature, the applicant's parent or guardian must sign the permit to validate it and the information provided before the mentored junior goes afield.

# **WORKING PAPERS INFORMATION**

The Office of Career & Technical Education is responsible for issuing work permits for all Philadelphia students ages 14 through 17. The School District of Philadelphia has created a process that will allow minors to obtain their working papers in two ways: Virtually by appointment and In-person by appointment.

### Instructions for obtaining a work permit in-person.

### Filling out the application

- 1. Download the application
- 2. Print it out.
- 3. Fill out everything except for "Signature of Issuing Officer" & the fields on the top right.
- 4. Have it signed by your parent or guardian, in the box at the bottom left. This part is important because they will not accept unsigned applications.
- 5. Go in to a walk-in site and bring:
  - You need to bring your completed application.
  - You need to bring a proof of age document, like a student ID that has your date of birth on it, or a copy of a birth certificate, a passport, etc.
  - You only need to bring yourself & those 2 documents (completed application & proof of age). It is optional for the parent or guardian to come with you.

### What if you don't have access to a printer?

- Blank applications are available on site. Please go with a parent or guardian as they will need to sign the application.
- Stand in line to see an issuing officer.
- Hand them your application & proof of age, they'll ensure everything is in order, and then they'll issue you a work permit (blue card).
- All personal documents will be returned except for the application.

# **PLAYSTREETS**

#### What We Do

More than 50 years ago, Philadelphia Parks & Recreation started Playstreets. This program closes designated streets to traffic so that kids have a safe place to play when school is out. A key feature of the program are the nutritious meals and snacks provided to children. This is important during the summer months when school meals are not available.

Playstreets take place in every neighborhood of the city. 300 to 350 city streets take part during the summer from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.



At each Playstreet:

- Playstreet supervisors open and close the streets to traffic each day.
- Parks & Rec's Summer Food Service Program provides daily lunches or snacks.
- Participants can use free play equipment and supplies.

#### **Process and Eligibility**

To be considered for Playstreets, your block must:

- Take part in the summer food program. (Serve free meals to children 18 and under).
- Have a block resident volunteer to be a Playstreet supervisor.
- Not be within two blocks of another approved Playstreet, playground, or rec center.
- Be a small, one-way street. No numbered street will be considered unless it is a dead end.
- Have 75 percent of residents on the block sign the petition agreeing to a Playstreet.

You must fill out an application to be considered for Playstreets status. All applications must go through an approval process before a Playstreets permit is issued.

# **DHS Intensive Prevention Services (IPS)**

If your child, or a child you know, is having issues at school, home, or in the community, Intensive Prevention Services (IPS) can help. IPS is a community-based prevention program offered to youth aged 10 to 19 who are at risk for involvement with the Juvenile Justice System. IPS provides meaningful programming through fun activities, experiences, and community engagement, promoting the healthy development of each child while addressing the behaviors that brought them into the program.

#### What to expect at IPS

Intensive Prevention Services (IPS) is a community-based prevention program offered to youth aged 10 to 19. IPS provides support to youth who are having issues at school or conflicts at home. The goal is to improve their behavior and prevent them from entering the juvenile justice system.

Through fun activities, meaningful experiences, and community engagement, IPS promotes the healthy development of each child brought into the program. Our providers create safe spaces to nurture the kinds of positive behaviors and skills that lead to healthy development.

Each participant gets a customized service plan to:

- Strengthen their sense of self-worth.
- Enhance life skills.
- Provide academic support.
- Improve relationships at home, at school, and in the community.

Youth are referred to IPS by families, schools, the court system, or the police department. Services are free and located in seven agencies across Philadelphia.

#### **Eligibility**

- Youth aged between 10-19
- Youth who are having reoccurring problems at home, school, or in the community
- Youth who are being diverted from arrest via the School Police Diversion Program
- Youth who need a safe space to learn and grow.

# **Community Evening Resource Centers (CERC)**

Community Evening Resource Centers (CERC) provide free, safe spaces and activities for kids and teens ages 10 to 17. You can take part in structured activities, do your homework, and make new friends.

Centers offer free, nightly activities like:

- Sports.
- Photography, cooking, yoga, and video-gaming classes.
- Community service projects.
- Job-readiness training.
- Conflict resolution and violence prevention training.

CERC staff mentor youth to encourage positive development. They can also connect youth to other programs and services that support schoolwork, mental health, and other needs.

#### How to attend CERC

All centers are free to attend for Philadelphia youth ages 10 to 17. You don't need to register or notify your CERC before you arrive.

CERC can also receive youth who are in violation of the City's minor curfew law and have come to the attention of the Philadelphia Police.

All centers are open every night from 7pm to 2am



As a legislator, she works to pass laws that address inequality, empower residents, and strengthen communities. Some of her legislative accomplishments include passing the Renters' Access Act, which reduced discrimination in the rental application and screening process; expanding protections for people seeking or providing abortions in Philadelphia; winning COVID-19 paid sick leave for workers, and fighting to return dozens of community gardens across the city back to community ownership.

Kendra's background is in community organizing. She spent years fighting for fully-funded public schools and against school closures. She is a trained restorative justice facilitator with a passion for tackling difficult issues and aligning people around shared interests. Her priorities include advocating for housing as a human right; creating safe, healthy neighborhoods in every zip code; and fighting for workers' rights and an economy that works for everyone.
